

# Confederate Capital Tour

3 DAYS, 2 NIGHTS

## DAY ONE

Begin the day with a tour of the [Virginia State Capitol](#), designed by Thomas Jefferson and the meeting place of the Confederate Congress during the War Between the States. Across the street, visit [St. Paul's Church](#), often called the "Church of the Confederacy", with its Tiffany windows in honor of Confederate Heroes. Then, it's on to Tredegar Iron Works- the [Richmond National Battlefield Park Headquarters](#). Next, visit the Seven Days Battlefield, just outside the city.

## DAY TWO

Begin today with a visit to the [Museum and White House of the Confederacy](#). The museum is home to the world's largest collection of Confederate artifacts; and the White House was the home of the Davis family from 1861-1865, and has been restored to look almost as it did when they lived there. From your motor coach, enjoy the many historic sites of Richmond, including Monument Avenue with its statues of Southern Heroes. We will stop in [Hollywood Cemetery](#), the final resting place of the entire Davis family, 25 Confederate generals and 18,000 Confederate dead. From here, we will travel to Fort Harrison or Cold Harbor battlefields. We will meet a live Confederate Soldier with a full display of both military and personal items of the common soldier (subject to availability).

## DAY THREE

Start your day with a visit to Grant's headquarters at City Point on the James River. Next, visit the [Petersburg Battlefield Park](#) and hear the story of the final year of the war. Followed by a complete tour of [Pamplin Historical Park and the National Museum of the Civil War Soldier](#). Conclude the day with a visit to [Blandford Church and Cemetery](#). This unique church houses world-famous Tiffany memorial windows and is the final resting place of 30,000 Confederate soldiers.
